- 4. To reveal the attractiveness of science education.
- 5. To promote mutual cooperation and dissemination of experience among students, teachers and professors of universities.
- 6. To develop practical skills by presenting natural science observations, experiments and research.
- 7. To encourage getting to know nature.
- 8. To develop skills of the research activity.

IV SECTION EXPECTED RESULTS

9. The participants of the conference will share good experience, acquire natural science knowledge and strengthen their abilities.

V SECTION PARTICIPANTS

- 10. The conference participants are students and teachers of secondary schools (gymnasiums/ high schools) of grades 9 12 from Lithuania and other countries as well as invited guests:

VIII SECTION PRESENTATION OF WORK

- 15. The report can be oral or in a poster form.
- 16. The reports may be presented in the form of slideshow and/or video footage. It is recommended to use Times New Roman font for the text. The names and surnames of the authors and their supervisors, the school, are written in the chosen size (it is important that it is clearly visible), and the title of the topic is in capital letters, bold font. The selected background of the presentations should be single-colour, without additional drawings that are not related to the research work, so as not to distract the attention of the audience.
- 17. Reports are read in Lithuanian and English.

IX SECTION PRESENTATIONS' REQUIREMENTS

- 18. Time limit for a student's presentation: 5-7 minutes.
- 19. The compliance of the research with the topic, goal and objective of the work, the relevance, significance, and importance of the work should be emphasized in the presentations. The results of the work are introduced, the conclusions of the work are presented, student's insights about the progress made in the development of subject and general competences are revealed (what was improved, what he learned, etc. while performing this work).
- 21. Students' reports must meet (or exceed) the regulations of the General Curriculum.

X SECTION ORGANIZATION OF THE CONFERENCE

- 22. Students present their work (natural science observations, experiments, research, etc.).
- 23. Teachers and high school teachers share their experiences.
